

MPriCE (Macmillan Primary Care Cancer Education) Project

Overview of combined survey results from GPs, Allied Health Professionals, Practice Nurses, Healthcare Assistants and Non-Clinical Staff within Primary Care.

<i>On average - respondents spend between 1-4 hours learning about cancer</i>	<i>82% of respondents prefer face-to-face learning followed by Online Learning 59%</i>	<i>The majority of respondents find out about cancer education via CCG Communication Bulletins followed by looking online</i>
<i>Importance of cancer education scale 1-10(Least-Extremely): 80% of respondents indicated the scale of importance higher than a 5</i>	<i>The online resources relevant and accessed by the different Survey User Groups were: Macmillan and CRUK</i>	<i>77% of respondents are in support of an online portal</i>
